






Job landscape






Projects

King - Game concepts for social change Dec 2020

In this project I had the 'Project Management' role. The challenge for this project new concept for an engaging game that would go against norms and that counchange which, for my team, was endangered animals awareness. The team wo remote and on-site, posing a new challenge to me as a PM to manage a team worked with teams fully on-site and fully remote but not hybrid. We have created and a 30 second Ad that was submitted to the judges, receiving the only 'hong judges.

Bank of America Infographic Challenge 2020 Feb 2020

My roles in this project were 'Data Analyst' and 'Project Manager'. The challenge of this project was to work in small teams to explore supplied data about London and identify a pressing social, health or environmental problem. Then, we've supported our findings with rigorous analysis of the data and created an infographic to present the analysis in a visually engaging way.

Having the two roles of project manager and data analyst has really challenged and helped me improve my organisational, prioritizing and leadership skills by requiring me to manage the team successfully while carrying out technical data tasks.

Deloitte - The Ada Student Al Challenge Jun 2020 – Jul 2020

My role in this project was 'Project Manager'. This project was done remotely, making it a tougher challenge to manage as a PM. The challenge was to Improve the student experience at Ada College using Al. Being remote challenged me to adapt my approach to and methods of communication to suit the circumstances. With one team member absent, I've taken the business role as well to finition the necessary deliverables and help the team get 3rd place in the competition.

Salesforce - Student Recruitment Challenge Dec 2019

My role in this project was the 'User Discovery Lead'. The aim of the project was to take the role of a Salesforce Solution Consultant, selling to Ada College. In teams, we evaluated what Salesforce can do to help Ada College meet its ambitious goals to recruit the next generation of Digital Pioneers and broaden its brand appeal in the education sector. We have created a pitch for the team's solution, and we have pitched it to the judges.


